ANNEXURE

Terms and Conditions

1. The CAG of India may suggest the appointment of a primary auditor to conduct the audit on his behalf and on the basis of directions/guidelines issued by him. Where such an auditor is appointed, the fees will be payable by the institution to that auditor. Where such an auditor is not appointed,

expenditure incurred by CAG of India in connection with the audit will be payable to him by the Institution.

- In addition to audit to be conducted by the primary Auditors, where so appointed, CAG of India will have the right to conduct test check of the accounts and to comment on and supplement the report of the primary Auditor.
- The CAG of India or any person appointed by him in connection with the audit, shall have the same rights, privileges and authority as the CAG has in connection with the audit of Government accounts.
- The result of audit will be communicated by CAG or any person appointed by him to the Governing body who shall submit a copy of the report alongwith its observations to the Government. The CAG will also forward a copy of the report direct to Government.
- The Audit entrusted to the CAG in public interest will be for a period of 5 years accounts from 1-4-2010 to 31-3-2015 in the first instance, subject to review of the arrangement after that period.
- The scope, extend and manner of conducting audit shall be as decided by the CAG of India.
- The CAG will have the right to report to Parliament/State Legislature the results of audit at his discretion.

(2) Demand No. 2: Flat Rise

It is demanded that all the Workmen shall be given the Flat Rise of ` 1,500/-. The said amount shall be added to the existing basic and thereafter fitted in the revised pay scale in the higher stage.

(3) Demand No. 3: Seniority Increments

It is demanded that the Workmen shall be given Seniority Increments as mentioned below:

Service from 4 years — Two increments

(4) Demand No. 4: Variable Dearness Allowance

It is demanded that the Variable Dearness Allowance shall be paid at the revised rate of Rs. 3/- per point above 2500 points (1960=100). The computation of Variable Dearness Allowance shall be made quarterly based as per existing system.

(5) Demand No. 5: House Rent Allowance

It is demanded that the House Rent Allowance shall be paid at the revised rate of 30% of Basic and Dearness Allowance, as the cost of accommodation is very high in Goa due to Tourist State.

(6) Demand No. 6: Children Education Allowance

It is demanded that Children Education Allowance shall be paid by adding an amount of Rs. 500/- to existing allowance per month.

(7) Demand No. 7: Conveyance Allowance

It is demanded that all Workmen shall be paid Conveyance Allowance at the rate of Rs. 750/- per month.

(8) Demand No. 8: Paid Holidays

(C) *Casual Leave* : All the Workmen shall be given Sick Leave at the rate of 15 days per year with a accumulation of 60 days.

(10) Demand No. 10: Leave Travel Allowance

It is demanded that Leave Travel Allowance shall be paid at the revised rate of Rs. 4,000/- per annum with minimum of four earned days leave. The amount shall be paid one week before the commencement of leave.

It is demanded that the existing Washing Allowance shall be revised to Rs. 350/- per month.

(15) Demand No. 15: Medical Expenses and Special Sick Leave

It is demanded that those Workmen who meet with accident while on duty shall be granted Special Sick Leave for the period they are under medical treatment and shall be reimbursed all Medical expenses incurred by him due to such accident.

(2) If the answer to issue No. (1) above is in the negative, then, what relief the Workmen are entitled to?"
