Read: Government Notification No. 1/1/94-PER (P.F.-I) dated 21-11-2006, published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 34 dated 23-11-2006.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (Central Act 10 of 1897), the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Government of Goa, Ravindra Bhavan, Fatorda, Directorate of Art and Culture, Panaji, Group 'C' and 'D', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted posts, Recruitment Rules, 2006, published vide Notification No. 1/1/94-PER (P.F.-I) dated 21-11-2006 in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I, No. 34 dated 23-11-2006, as follows, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Ravindra Bhavan, Fatorda, Directorate of Art and Culture, Panaji, Group 'C' and 'D', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted posts (First Amendment), Recruitment Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of Schedule.*— In the Government of Goa, Ravindra Bhavan, Fatorda, Directorate of Art and Culture, Panaji, Group 'C' and 'D', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted posts, Recruitment Rules, 2006, in the Schedule,—

(b) in column (10), for the expression "By direct recruitment.", the expression "By promotion, failing which, by direct recruitment.", shall be substituted;

(c) in column (11), for the letters and figures "N. A.", the expression "Promotion: Assistant Air Condition Operator with 3 years regular service in the grade.", shall be substituted;
