*(Under Section 24 of the Goa Value Added Tax Act, 2005, read with sub-rule (1) of Rule 23 of the Goa Value Added Tax Rules, 2005 and sub-section (2) of Section 9 of the Central Sales Tax Act, 1956)*

Whereas, the undersigned has been delegated powers vide second proviso to sub-rule (1) of Rule 23 of the Goa Value Added Tax Rules, 2005, to extend the date for better compliance of the tax returns, beyond 30 days from the end of the quarter without payment of penalty, as a special case.

And whereas, I am satisfied that there is genuine need to extend the period for filing of returns for the first quarter of 2015-16 commencing from quarter from 01-04-2015 to 30-06-2015, beyond 30-07-2015, also for better compliance.

I therefore, in exercise of the powers delegated to me vide the second proviso to sub-rule (1) of Rule 23 of the principal Rules, extend the last date for filing of quarterly returns for the quarter ending 30th June, 2015, "as a special case", upto 28th August, 2015. All the assesses registered under the Goa Value Added Tax Act, 2005 (Act 9 of 2005) other than composition dealers are accordingly required to file their quarterly returns for the quarter ending 30-06-2015 on or before 28th

August, 2015; failure to file returns within the extended time shall attract penalties as provided in Section 55 of the said Act.

And whereas the notification requires the preparation of a Zonal Master Plan for effective management of ESZ for each Protected Area within a period of 2 years from the date of its publication for consideration and approval of MoEF & CC; and

And whereas the Zonal Master Plan is to be prepared with the involvement of concerned State Departments for integrating the ecological and environmental considerations in the Plan; and

And whereas the State Level Eco-sensitive Zone Monitoring Committee (SESZMC), Goa has in its meeting held on 29-05-2015 decided that as the land details are already available with the Town & Country Planning Department, the Chief Town Planner, shall get the draft Zonal Master Plan for each Eco-Sensitive Zone prepared.

Whereas the Government of Goa is of the opinion that an industrial dispute exists between M/s. Goa Bagayatdar Sahakari Kharedi Vikri Saunsta Maryadit, Ponda, Goa, and their workmen, represented by the Goa Trade and Commercial Workers' Union, in respect of the matter specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "said dispute");

And whereas the Government of Goa considers it expedient to refer the said dispute for adjudication.



Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act 14 of 1947) (hereinafter referred to as the "said Act"), the Government of Goa hereby refers the said dispute for adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal of Goa at Panaji-Goa constituted under Section 7-A of the said Act.

#### SCHEDULE

“(1) Whether the action of M/s. Goa Bagayatdar Sahakari Kharedi Vikri Saunstha Maryadit, Ponda, Goa, in not considering the following demands of the workmen raised through the Goa Trade and Commercial Workers' Union, vide their letter No. Goa Bagayatdar (49)/Request for intervention/2014 dated 12-08-2014, is legal and justified?

#### Charter of Demands

##### (i) Washing Allowance:

The management has not paid the Washing Allowance @ Rs. 200/- per month to the Mparis and to Clerks w.e.f. January, 2014.

##### (ii) Bonus:

The management has also not paid Bonus-cum-Ex-Gratia @ 20% to all the workmen and staff employees employed at Goa Bagayatdar Sahakari Kharedi Vikri Saunstha Maryadit Society for the year, 2014.

##### (iii) Cash Handling Allowance:

The management has not paid Cash Handling Allowance to the clerks @ Rs. 250/- per month.

##### (iv) Bhatta Charges:

The management has not paid the Bhatta charges to the drivers at the revised rate of Rs. 150/- per day effective from January, 2014.

##### (v) Promotions:

Many workmen are due for promotion as most of the workmen are working in the same grade and category for more than 10 years and above. These workmen are entitled for immediate promotions to the next higher grade.

##### (vi) Transfers:

Many workmen have been transferred to the far-off places due to which many workmen find it extremely difficult to

report for duties at the transferred places. The Union had demanded that a transparent transfer Policy be thoroughly discussed with the Union and no transfers be done beyond the radius of 20 kms. from his or her place of residence. Further, all those workmen who have been transferred beyond 20 kms. radius to be brought back to the nearest place.

##### (vii) Overtime:

The management is not paying the Over-time for working on extended hours @ double the wage. We request that whenever any workman work on extended hours he/she be paid overtime @ double the wage.

##### (viii) Encashment of Leave:

The unavailed leave (sick leave as well as) leave which is due to the credit of each of the workperson should be allowed to be encashed.

##### (ix) Union Meetings:

The Committee members of the Union be allowed to attend the Office of Labour Commissioner, Industrial Court and other competent authority where the cases of workpersons are pending including the Union office at Panaji as and when required as 'on duty' (OD).

##### (x) Union Membership:

The Union Membership fee of all the workperson be deducted at source from January salary @ Rs. 100/- per month and be paid to "Goa Trade & Commercial Workers' Union Bagayatdar, Ponda, Goa.

##### (xi) Golden Jubilee:

All the workmen and staff employees be paid Rs. 10,000/- each as a GIFT on the occasion of Golden Jubilee of 'Goa Bagayatdar Sahakari Kharedi Vikri Saunstha Marayadit'.

##### (xii) Seniority Weightage:

That w.e.f. 01-01-2014 all workmen and staff employees be paid one extra increment for every five years of service. For example:—

Those who have completed five (5) years be paid one increment.

Those who have completed ten (10) years two increments, and so on ....

(xiii) The salaries of all the workmen to be revised in accordance with VIth Pay Commission recommendations. This genuine demand has been pending since the year 2006.

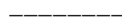

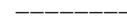

The Mission (NULM) is to reduce Poverty and vulnerability of the Urban Poor Households by enabling them to access gainful Self-Employment and skilled wage employment opportunity, resulting in an appreciable improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis, through building strong grassroots level institutions of the poor. The Mission would also aim at providing shelter equipped with essential services to the Urban homeless in a phased manner. In addition, the mission would also address livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable space, institutional credit, social security and skills to the urban street vendors for accessing emerging market opportunities.

The Mission is presently applicable to District Headquarter Cities as recommended by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation and the Mission will also be made applicable to the other Cities as per the approval accorded by the Government.

Accordingly, as per the National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM) guidelines issued by the Government of India and with the approval of the State Government, the Goa State Urban Development Agency (GSUDA) is also designated as Goa State Urban Livelihoods Mission (GSULM). The Director of Urban Development will be the Mission Director for the GSULM. The GSULM will be funded with the funds available under NULM, Rajiv Awas Yojana, National Urban Renewal Mission (NURM).

The Government further orders the formation of Governing Council and Executive Committee, at the State Level. The Governing Council will be headed by the Hon. Minister for Urban Development/Dy. Chief Minister and will provide overall guidance on the formulation of the State Urban Poverty Alleviation Programme and monitor the implementation across the State. The Governing Council shall meet at least once a year.
