AWARD

(Passed on this 8th day of June, 2015)

By order dated 16-07-1998, bearing No. IRM/CON/VSC/(14)/98/9773, the Government of Goa in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d)

of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (for short The Act) has referred the following dispute for adjudication.

“(1) Whether the action of the management of M/s Varsha Printing Press, near the M.P.T. Hospital, Baina, Vasco-da-Gama, Goa in terminating the services of Miss Pratima Bhagat, with effect from 14-2-1997, is legal and justified?

(2) If not, to what relief the workman is entitled?”

2. Upon receipt of the reference, a case was registered under No. IT/65/98 and registered AD notices were issued to both the parties and upon service, Party I filed the claim statement at Exb. 4 and Party II filed the written statement at Exb. 5. Party I then filed the rejoinder at Exb. 8.

3. In the claim statement it is in short the case of Party I/workman that she was in the employment of Party II w.e.f 8-6-91. It is stated that her services were terminated on 14-2-97 and prior to this there were some discussions with the proprietor over the payment of minimum wages to all the employees, as recommended by the Government. It is stated that refusal of Party II to pay minimum wages resulted in termination of her services orally. It is stated that she has requested Party II to clear her legal dues but the owner told her that he has no dues with him and drove her away. It is stated that Party I then wrote a letter to Asst. Labour Commissioner, Vasco-da-Gama for action however despite discussions, the matter could not be settled. It is stated that termination of her services by Party II is illegal and bad in law as Party II failed to comply with the provisions of Sec. 25F of the Act. Party I has therefore prayed to hold that the action of Party II in orally terminating the services of Party I as illegal; to declare that Party I is entitled for payment of full back wages for the period from 14-2-97 and to direct Party II to reinstate Party I in the services of Party II w.e.f. 14-2-97 with continuity of services.

4. In the written statement Party II has denied the case pleaded in the claim statement and has stated that the printing press is a small establishment and that the family members and the children of the owner assist him in the business of printing. It is stated that Party II establishment is not an Industry and thus the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act are not applicable. It is stated that Party I was employed on hourly basis and was engaged as and when the work was surplus and could not be executed

by the owner. It is stated that Party I was assigned work during the period 1995 to 1997. It is stated that services of Party I were never terminated in as much as the Party I was never in the employment of Party II. It is stated that Party I failed to report or carry out any assignment whenever she was informed that such assignment was to be executed. It is stated that therefore there was no question of payment of legal dues to her. Party II has denied that the termination of services of Party I is illegal or bad in law. Party II has therefore submitted that Party I is not entitled for reinstatement with back wages as prayed for.

5. In the rejoinder Party I has denied the case setup by Party II in the written statement and has asserted her case pleaded in the claim statement.

6. On the basis of the averments of the respective parties, issues dated 23-2-2000 at Exb. 9 were framed.

7. In the course of evidence, Party I Kum. Pratima Bhagat examined herself and closed the evidence. On the other hand, Party II examined only Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade and closed their case.

8. Heard Ld. Rep. Shri K.V. Nadkarni for Party I and Ld. Adv. Shri P. Chawdikar for Party II.

9. I have gone through the records of the case and have duly considered the arguments advanced. I am reproducing the issues along with their findings and reasons thereof.

REASONS

10. *Issue No. 3:* This issue is answered before answering the remaining issues since it goes to the root of the case. In the written statement it is the case of Party II that the Printing Press is a small establishment with a negligible turn over and is essentially run with the active participation of the members of the family. It is also the case of Party II in the written statement that all along he has been assisted by only one employee at a time and he has never employed more than one employee at any point of time. Thus, according to Party II the said establishment is not an Industry and the provisions of the Act are not applicable and therefore the reference deserves to be dismissed.

11. In her evidence Party I has stated that in the establishment of Party II there were four persons including her and their names were Joseph, Prakash and Joanita. It is worthwhile noting that neither in the claim statement nor in the rejoinder Party I has mentioned the names of above person as the ones who were working with her in the establishment of Party II. Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade has also denied the suggestion that four employees namely, Joseph, Prakash, Joanita and Party I were working with him during the period from 1991 to 1994. Being so, such statement made by Party I before the court is apparently by way of after thought and thus cannot be accepted.

12. I have already pointed out above, that it is the case of Party II in the written statement that only one person was assisting him in the Printing Press at a time, however in his evidence Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade has stated that he never employed more than one employee at any point of time. In the above context, in his cross examination Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade has made it clear that he purchased the Printing Press from one Mr. Beig in the year 1979 and at that time one employee was employed by said Mr. Beig who continued to work till about the year 1982 or 1983 and then left the services. He has also stated that since then only his family members are working to assist him in running the Printing Press. It is worthwhile noting that the above explanation given by Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade is not denied by Party II. Being so, it is clear that Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade never employed more than one employee at any point of time. Thus, it is clear that the establishment of Party II is a small business activity without there being any organized labour in the employment of Party II.

13. Ld. Advocate for Party II in the above context relied on the judgment in the case of **Umashankar Jaswal v/s Royal Auto Centre & Anr. 1998 1 CLR 740**, the observations in which indicate that a small upmarketing business carried on by the employer cannot be termed as systematic activity organized by co-operation between employer and employee for distribution of goods and it does not fall within the definition of Industry. Thus in the light of above observations, it can be safely concluded that Party II is not an Industry and therefore the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 are not applicable to the instant case. Hence my findings.

14. In view of findings on issue No. 3 the need to answer the remaining issues does not arise, nevertheless, since the parties have lead evidence, I find it proper to answer even the remaining issues.

15. *Issue No. 1:* It is stated by Party I that she was working with Party II since 8-6-91 as trainee and thereafter stopped working. She has stated that the employer then sent her message to join the services and upon this she joined the services of Party II as composer. It may be mentioned that Party I has not stated in her chief examination, the date on which she joined Party II as composer, but in her cross examination Party I has stated that she has been working with Party II as a composer since March 1997. It is worthwhile mentioning that Party I has not produced any document to show that she was employed with Party II from 8-6-91 as a trainee or from any other date as a composer.

16. Even in the cross examination of Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade though it is suggested that Party I was employed in his Printing Press from 8-6-91, this witness has denied the said suggestion. It may be mentioned that no suggestion has been put to Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade stating that Party I was employed with Party II from 8-6-91 as a trainee and from August 1992 she worked as a composer. Even for that matter, Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade has also not been asked to produce any specific documentary evidence showing the name of Party I as his employee, during the period mentioned above. The documents produced on record through Party I are the complain dated 20-2-97 by Party I to ALC Vasco-d-Gama (Exb. W-1), notice dated 7-4-97 (Exb. W-2) by ALC Vasco-da-Gama to Party II, notices issued by ALC Vasco-da-Gama to both the parties informing them the dates fixed for discussions (Exb. W-3 colly), the minutes of meeting dated 9-1-98 at

Exb. (W-4) and the failure report dated 6-7-98 at (Exb. W-5). Perusal of the minutes of meeting at Exb. W. 4 reveals that Party II did not attend the meeting on that date. The failure report at Exb. W-5 colly indicates that joint discussions were held on several occasions but Party II attended on four occasions. Perusal of this report does not give any idea as to what was the contention of Party II during the discussions held. Nevertheless, the fact that remains is that there is no documentary evidence on record to establish that Party I was employed with Party II as a trainee from 8-6-91 and thereafter from August 1992, she worked as a composer.

17. It may be mentioned that it is the defence of Party II in the written statement that Party I was employed on hourly basis and she was not required to report at a particular time. It is also the case of Party II that the requirement of Party I for work was conveyed at her residence. No doubt, the suggestion that Party II used to send message to Party I at her residence as and when there was pressure of work and that Party I was being paid according to the number of hours of work, has been denied by Party I in her cross examination however in the absence of any positive evidence from Party I in support of this issue I have no other option then to hold that Party I, has failed to prove this issue. Hence my findings.

18. *Issue No. 2:* Party I having failed to prove issue No. 1, the question of proving this issue does not arise. This is because, there is no documentary evidence on record indicating that Party I was in continuous employment with Party II prior to the alleged termination of her services by Party II. Thus, there is no question of said termination being illegal and unjustified. Even for that matter, though it is stated by Party I that Mr. Fedric Pereira Andrade i.e. Proprietor of Party II upon being requested by her to increase the salary got annoyed, gave her bad words and tried to assault and thereafter told her to get out, no such suggestion has been put to Shri Fedric Pereira Andrade in his cross examination. Therefore such case projected by Party I cannot apparently be believed. This being the case and irrespective of the fact of failure of Party I to prove issue No. 1, this issue stands answered in the negative.

19. *Issue No. 4:* In view of above discussion it is clear that Party I is not entitled to any relief.

20. In the result, I pass the following:

ORDER

1. It is hereby held that the present dispute does not survive and therefore the reference is not maintainable.
2. No order as to costs.
Inform the Government accordingly.
